

30 DAY STICK IDEAS



Collect 5 different sticks. Compare their lengths.



Draw patterns in mud or sand with a stick.



Build a tiny bridge with sticks and stones



Balance a stick on your hand. Can you walk with it?



Make music: tap sticks together to create rhythms.



Sort sticks by thickness or colour.



Create a trail using sticks as arrows.



Build a den using sticks and a blanket.



Make a stick family: add faces with chalk or string.



Float sticks in water. Which float best?



Count how many steps long your stick is.



Use sticks as magic wands in pretend play.



Build the tallest free-standing stick tower



Make a mini animal home using logs and sticks.



Write letters or numbers in mud with sticks.



Line up sticks from shortest to longest.



Create a stick picture frame on the ground.



Play 'follow the leader' balancing on logs.



Use sticks as fishing rods in pretend play.



Tap sticks gently on different surfaces. What sounds do you hear?



Pretend sticks are spoons and cook a mud recipe



Create stick puppets and make up a story



Balance two sticks to make a cross. What can you build from it?



Use logs as drums. Try loud and quiet beats.



Make a stick trail and challenge friends to follow.



Build a campfire circle (pretend) with sticks and stones.



Paint with sticks dipped in mud or water.



Place a stick in the ground and trace its shadow at different times of day. Notice how it moves.



Use sticks to tap on logs, fences, or pots. Can you make a rhythm together as a group?
